

## Elaborate

How to play The game questions are on 2" x 11" strips of brightly colored/graphic laminated card stock. All the strips are different, and all original graphics by the creator. Each player takes a strip (when it is their turn) only one player draws a strip at a time so all of the focus is on the player answering the question. Most often this will then spark more conversation. If you draw a "wild card" you may ask someone to continue to "elaborate" on their question, or make one up of your own. The twists and turns that the conversation takes when people elaborate is what people love about the game. Very simple but VERY fun and you find out all kinds of things about people. a question word game that sparks the "art of conversation" some samples are: 1. First time I felt powerful... 2.
